Plenary lectures, oral and best poster presentations will be published in special issues of Russian Journal of General Chemistry and Russian Journal of Applied Chemistry (publications of Russian Academy of Sciences).

Abstract Submission

Online registration is available on the conference website or a registration form can be requested by email. The contributed abstract size is limited to 2 pages and should be submitted in electronic form according to the guidelines below. Abstracts should be submitted to the Organizing Committee by e-mail: ALD_Rus-2017@technolog.edu.ru.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject or alter abstracts that do not satisfy the preparation requirements.

Formatting guidelines for abstracts

Abstracts of one or two *full pages A4 (210×297 mm)* should be composed in Microsoft Word 97-2003 format.

Abstract Word document margins 16×22 cm. The headers sequence as follows: a Presentation Title (bold heading); 2 mm down – Names of Authors (underlined presenter's name); 2 mm down – Affiliation of Authors (italic); 3 mm down – the main text of an abstract. Headers should be centered.

The paragraph first line indent of 1 cm is required. The line spacing is single. The Times New Roman font is strongly recommended, font size of main text should be 12 points. References in the text should be marked by square brackets. The numerated list of bibliographical data should follow the main text after 2 mm vertical space.

The following is a short example of abstracts formatting:
